- Large book bag (NO WHEELS PLEASE!)
- 3 boxes of 8-count crayons (Crayola is the best quality)
- 2 boxes of 24-count crayons (Crayola is the best quality)
- 1 pair of Fiskar brand scissors
- 2 double bottom-pocket folders
- 1 box of washable markers
- 2 dry erase markers, black or blue
- 2 glue sticks (Elmer's washable disappearing purple works best)
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 oversized t-shirt or art smock for art activities
- A full change of clothing for your child in a large zip lock bag clearly labeled with his/her name. (Please label all pieces of clothing. The clothes will come in handy for any accidents that may occur during the year. Clothing that is appropriate for every season works best.)

The Essentials

- Large backpack (lunch and folders should easily fit inside)
- 4 boxes of 24-count crayons

- 1 pair of scissors (Fiskar brand is preferred)
- 4 double bottom-pocket plastic folders:
 - o 1 red, 1 blue, 1 green
 - o 1 of any design for your child's take-home folder (plastic for durability)
- 1 plastic, snap closure pencil box (not oversized, about 8 inches long)
- 1 box of markers
- 1 box of fine-point markers (optional)
- 4 dry erase markers, black or blue (Expo is the best quality, the skinny, bullet-tip style is best for handwriting purposes.)
- 1 pair of quality, well-fitting, wired headphones (over-the-head, not earbuds, not wireless or USB)
- 3 large(standard-sized) boxes of tissues
- 1 oversized t-shirt for art activities, labeled with your child's name
- A full change of clothing in a large zip lock bag clearly labeled with your child's name. (Please label all pieces of clothing. Clothing that is appropriate for every season works best.)

Dear Parents/Guardians.

With the end of the school year quickly upon us, we know that you are making plans for your child's summer vacation activities. The summer months are a welcome opportunity for fun and relaxation, but the break from school activities often causes students to experience a lag in learning upon returning to school in the fall.

Research tells us children who do not read during the summer may lose a month or more of the reading progress they had made in school. Therefore, it is crucial to keep your children engaged in summer reading activities.

For summer reading, the 5th Grade students are asked to read **one book of their choice**. After reading the book, we ask that students write a **one paragraph summary** that will be collected on the first day of school.

In addition to reading during the summer, we are also asking that students practice their **math skills and facts**. Mastery of these facts is important in order to develop a solid math foundation.
