With the end of the school year quickly upon us, we know that you are making plans for your child's summer vacation activities. The summer months are a welcome opportunity for fun and relaxation, but the break from school activities often causes students to experience a lag in learning upon returning to school in the fall.

Research tells us children who do not read during the summer may lose a month or more of the reading progress they had made in school. Therefore, it is crucial to keep your children engaged in summer reading activities.

For summer reading, the 5th Grade students are asked to read **one book of their choice**. Some reading opportunities would be RAZ kids, the public library or the bag of books from Ms. Sabbatino. After reading the book, we ask that students write a **one paragraph summary** that will be collected on the first day of school.

In addition to reading during the summer, we are also asking that students practice their **math skills and facts**. Mastery of these facts is important in order to develop a solid math foundation.
