Every month I crunch the numbers to see what more I can do to try to interest our students to come enjoy meals with us.

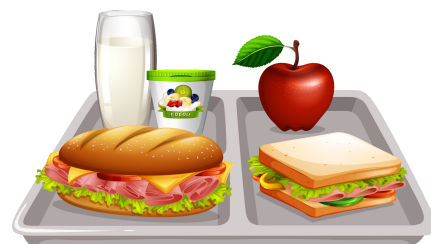
During January

only **27 % of them came for a FREE breakfast** and
58 % came for a FREE lunch

In the jr-sr high, with an enrollment of 734
only **15 % came in for a FREE breakfast** and
45 % came for a FREE lunch.

In order for our district to continue to qualify for FREE MEALS,
we need participation. We've worked very hard to make this happen for our kids, We scratch cook at least 75% of our meals and we offer FRESH LOCAL, fruits and vegetables as well as NYS Milk and Beef products. We have beautiful salad bars and multiple meal choices each day.
